Nearly 80% of HCPs consider honoraria their number 1 or 2 factor impacting their decision to respond to a phone interview invitation. **20**[%] indicate personal busy-ness or **study topic** as their number 1 factor.

What Makes a **Good Interview**?

Panelists most frequently mention the quality of questions and the moderator as the factors that contribute to a good interview.

The Questions

Clarity in questions, interesting questions, 39% allowing room for open ended discussion and an absence of repetitive questions

The Moderator

35%

Friendliness, engagement and knowledge of the subject matter

The Time

21% Being respectful of HCP time; keeping the conversation moving

The Topic

An interesting topic that leaves room for discussion

"Some moderators are terrific; easy to talk to, clearly knowledgeable, and I want to share info... A good interviewer makes you feel valuable, responds politely, and is friendly.

"The moderator should be organized and keep the interview moving and on schedule."
